Preliminary information

Installation and fitment instructions includes the tools required, fasteners included in the kit, and the hardware included in the kit.

Please follow the instructions and check installation steps with the images in this document.

Alu-Cab recommends that all sealing work is allowed to cure for 24 hours, after which you may drive the vehicle on normal paved roads. Before driving off-road with your Alu-Cab product or operating your roof conversion, an additional cure period of 48 hours is required.

Failure to follow these instructions will void your warranty. Please ensure that you follow the sealant manufacturers curing time as per their technical data sheet

M8 Flat Washer	1
M6 Nylock Nut	4

M8x20 Cup square bolt	3
M8 Nylock Nut	3
M8 Plastic Nut Cap	3

Fit the canvas over the bolt by placing a small M6 washer on the bottom and top side of the canvas and using the extra M6 Nyloc nuts supplied. NB! DO NOT LOOSEN THESE BOLTS Bolt 1: (situated inside the lid of the tent at the rear end of the cargo rail)







The bolts at the rear end and mid of the cargo rail, situated inside the lid of the tent

Fit the spring pole bracket 120 to 180mm from the start of the cargo rail. Based on the ideal positions below you can fit the tent mounting bracket as required.


Alternatively, should you not have enough space on the leff-hand side, the Spring Pole Bracket could also be mounted on the right-hand side of the cargo rail as specified below:





Setting up the Rain Cover Sheet: Clip the rain cover fly sheet to the gas strut with the black clip as shown below.

Use the Buckle strap on the flysheet and loop it through the spring pole and fly sheet bracket as seen below.







Use one of the spring poles supplied in the flysheet kit to pop the flysheet into its intended shape.

Lastly attach the Velcro on the flysheet to the Velcro on the canvas to keep the fly sheet in place.

Packing the Side Rain Cover away: Simply unstrap the Cam Buckle strap, and unclip the black clip on the gas strut. Remove the spring pole to roll the rain cover sheet up and strap it in with the Alu-Cab straps as seen below.
